Application should be submitted with scanned copy of Identity Card issued from College/University& passport size photograph of the applicantalongwith a recommendation letter issued by principal /HOD of Law Department. In case desired documents are not attached, then application will not be considered. Savein exceptionalcases& circumstances the Authority shall have discretion to waive off the condition.

- **19thDecember, 2023**

Enrolled/ Shortlisted students will be informed via e-mail. Students will be shortlisted on the basis of draw of lots, if more than required applications are received.

- **21st December, 2023**

Students shall send a confirmation e-mail of their participation in Internship program positively within 3 days of receiving information of being shortlisted.
