## **RULES AND REGULATIONS-**

---

1. The Competition would be conducted in an **online** mode.
2. Any form of identification mark of the Participant is restricted on the legislative policy draft submission.
3. Submission of the file to be made in .doc or .docx file.
4. Submission made by the Participants is to be titled Submission for Legislation Policy Drafting Competition (TC) which shall be provided after the registrations in due time.
5. The Legislative Policy Drafts submitted by the Participants must be their original work. Use of AI is strictly prohibited for the Competition.
6. No Participant submissions will be entertained after the last submission date.
7. After the conclusion of the Competition, the organizers hold every right on the drafts submitted.
8. *Eligibility and Team Composition-* The Competition is open to all students pursuing any degree (Bachelors'/Masters'/etc.) from a recognised college or University.
9. There are *no restrictions* on the number of Participants from one University.
10. The Participants can register individually as well as in a team that may comprise a maximum number of two members. Participants can duly register by dully filling the registration for [here](#).
11. There will be a *registration fee* of ₹200 (Single Participant) and ₹400 (Co-Authorship up to 2 Participants) for the Competition.

# DETAILED SUBMISSION GUIDELINES-

---

## **1. Theme and Focus**

- The policy proposal must align with the Competition's theme and focus areas, as outlined in the Competition announcement or guidelines.
- Submissions unrelated to the specified theme will not be considered.

## **2. Format and length**

- Submissions must be in English and should be provided in a clear and concise manner.
- The recommended length for the policy proposal *must not exceed* 15 pages.
- The font must be – Times New Roman or any other standard font at the Team’s discretion.  
The font size must be – 12 and the headings and sub-headings can be accordingly best suited.
- Line spacing must be 1.5
- The alignment must be – justified.
- The Final Policy Draft must comprise of the following:
  - i. COVER PAGE
  - ii. TABLE OF CONTENTS
  - iii. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
  - iv. SUMMARY OF THE POLICY PROPOSAL
  - v. POLICY PROPOSAL CONTENT
  - vi. POLICY OBJECTIVES
  - vii. LITERATURE REVIEW AND BACKGROUND
  - viii. POLICY PROPOSAL
  - ix. POLICY COMPONENTS
  - x. IMPLEMENTATION PLAN
  - xi. FEASIBILITY AND COST BENEFIT ANALYSIS
  - xii. STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATION/ENGAGEMENT
  - xiii. ETHICAL CONSIDERATION
  - xiv. PUBLIC SUPPORT AND COMMUNICATION

- xv. WAY FORWARD/CONCLUSION
- xvi. REFERENCES

### 3. Cover Page-

The cover page must include the following information:

- Title of the Policy Proposal
- Team Code of the Policy (to be assigned by the Organizing Committee)
- Any relevant logo that the Teams would want to include and make the Cover page attractive.
