

Submission Guidelines:

- Participants are invited to submit an extended abstract (300 500 words) relevant to the central theme of the Conclave in Word Document format. Co-authorship of up to only two authors is permitted.
- Formatting Guidelines:
- a. Single Column, A4 Size, 1.5-line spacing
- b. Font Style: Times New Roman, Size 12
- Each submission must include a cover page with the following details:
- a. Title of the Long Abstract
- **b.** Author(s)
- c. Affiliation(s)
- d. Contact Details

(including an active email address and mobile number)

- Experts will review abstracts, and only those approved by the reviewers will be selected and notified to the authors.
- Acceptance implies that at least one author will attend the Conclave and present (Online/Offline).
- Only original, unpublished work will be considered.
 Proposals presenting identical or substantially similar work already published or under review elsewhere will not be accepted.
- All papers shall be strictly subjected to antiplagiarism software and scrutinised through blind
 review of the Editorial board. The paper should be
 original and unpublished work of the author(s), and
 plagiarism is strictly prohibited. Plagiarism
 criteria: 10 per cent, excluding footnotes and
 bibliography.
- The sub-themes provided are merely indicative and not exhaustive. Participants are free to choose any topic relevant to the conclave's central theme.
