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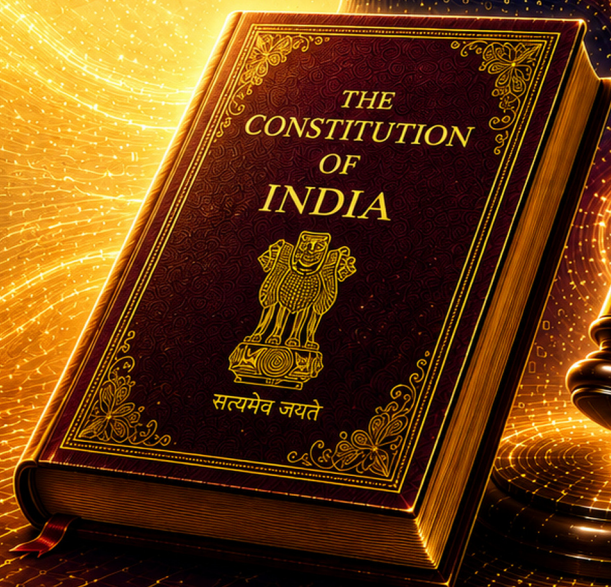

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Artificial Intelligence, machine learning, generative and agentic systems, blockchain, data analytics and allied emerging technologies are no longer at the margins of legal practice — they are reshaping how law is researched, drafted, argued, adjudicated and taught. Generative AI now drafts pleadings, summarises judgments, predicts outcomes and produces student assessments; regulators worldwide are simultaneously scrambling to govern the very tools they must rely upon.

For the law teacher, this creates a twin obligation. First, to *teach about* these technologies — the doctrinal, ethical and regulatory questions they raise. Second, to *teach with* them — redesigning pedagogy, assessment and research supervision for classrooms in which every student already carries an AI assistant. Neither obligation can be met by curiosity alone; both require structured, hands-on capacity building.

This six-day online Faculty Development Programme has been designed to meet exactly that need. Conducted by distinguished national and international resource persons drawn from academia, the judiciary, the legal profession and the technology sector, it combines conceptual grounding with practical demonstration, and closes with participant presentations so that learning translates into classroom practice.

OBJECTIVES

- ◆ To familiarise law teachers with the foundations, vocabulary and current capabilities of Artificial Intelligence and allied emerging technologies.
- ◆ To equip participants with practical pedagogical tools and techniques for integrating technology into legal teaching, assessment and evaluation.
- ◆ To strengthen competence in AI-assisted legal research, academic writing and research supervision, while safeguarding rigour and originality.
- ◆ To examine the ethical, regulatory and academic-integrity questions arising from the use of AI in legal education and the justice delivery system.
- ◆ To encourage curriculum innovation and institutional readiness for technology-integrated legal education.
- ◆ To build a continuing network of law teachers engaged with law, technology and governance.
